- Treasurer's Report (Elisabeth Cherry/Darbi Kaltakdjian)
 - Current Balance and Start of Year Funds - we are a nonprofit, our funding comes from corporate donations, fundraising, membership
 - Budget Concerns for 2025/2026 - we have a much smaller budget due to fundraising problems than we have in previous years. Membership dues are down from projected \$5000 to \$3000. Last year we used old pass through funds to purchase big items like picnic tables. We are working on a \$23K budget this year vs. \$27k. We spend $\frac{1}{4}$ on teachers, $\frac{1}{4}$ on students (every student got a wham tshirt), the other goes to general things that we need for campus improvements and events. We are looking for a big ticket fundraiser with companies that will help us raise money like Barnes and Noble used to with sales.

- Summer Updates (Susie McGlone)
 - Teacher's Lounge - finished painting nurse's station cabinets and windows, installed new countertop cover. Also painted Dr.Hite's office windows and bathroom and pressure washed throughout campus.
 - Pre-k and Kindergarten playgrounds were cleaned and soft washed
 - PTO Work Day - cleaned windows, window planters redone in garden, carpet cleaned in lounge, new soccer goal nets (Barnes Family), soft washed WHAM-A-LAMA, finished building picnic tables for 4th/5th grade, general garden clean up

- School Beautification - new lily pads/flowers painted for carpoolers (Becky Tremblay), gardens were refreshed (Kim Shaw)
- Committee Updates and New Chairs (Jenna deBarros)
